I am pleased to advise that the Dean (Learning and Teaching), Griffith Sciences has now approved credit articulation arrangements as below:

- 80CP credit transfer awarded towards Bachelor of Information Technology (1538/1539), Nathan and Gold Coast campus (240CP/3 year degree), for completion of the NZ Diploma in Information Technology Technical Support (1 year).
- 140CP credit transfer awarded towards the Bachelor of Information Technology (1538/1539), Nathan and Gold Coast campus (240CP/3 year degree), for completion of the NZ Diploma in Information Technology Technical Support (1 year) + NZ Diploma in Systems Administration (1 year).



Students will be required to meet the standard Griffith University program academic admission criteria.

These arrangements will remain current whilst both International College of Auckland and Griffith University offer the Diploma in Information Technology Technical Support and the Diploma in Systems Administration and the Bachelor of Information Technology (1538/1539). If there are significant changes to either institution's programs, the articulation arrangement will need to be reviewed at time of the major change to ensure currency of the arrangement.
