

Zero Fee Scheme and Consent

(2- Years Diploma in Electrical Engineering Level-7)

Terms and Conditions

1. The zero fee scheme is only for New Zealand citizens/ residents/Australian permanent residents living in NZ.
2. Zero fee applies to the base tuition fee. The program may incur nominal additional costs to students such as RPL fee, curricular, extra-curricular activities and others.
3. Although, it is intended by ICA to continue the zero fee scheme, the current zero fee scheme is only valid for this intake. This may change subject to a result of the present ICA and Government policies.
4. Following criteria apply to students, applying for the zero fee scheme
 - Qualification completion
 - Minimum 80% attendance
 - Adequate progression in academics
 - Ongoing engagement with qualification
 - Adherence to the ICA and engineering department rules and requirements
5. Zero fee scheme can be withdrawn if above criteria requirements are not met. The student can still continue studies but will be required to pay remaining full fee (\$1000 NZD for each paper).
6. If a student withdraws from program then student will be responsible to inform **studylink**.
7. Student needs to contact with Head of Department in case of withdrawal and transfer from the program.
8. If a student withdraws from the programme or any paper, he/she will not be eligible for the zero fee scheme for the program/paper. However he/she can enrol at later days after showing adequate performance in other papers or after the approval of HoD.
9. All matters relating to student rights and responsibilities will be handled in accordance with ICA's policies and procedures.
