New Zealand Diploma in Engineering (NZDE)

The New Zealand Diploma in Engineering (NZDE) is a 240-credit qualification, over two years full-time, with strands in Civil, Electrical, Electronic, Mechanical and Fire Engineering. The qualification is registered at level 6 on the <u>New Zealand Qualifications and Credentials Framework.</u>

The NZDE is owned by <u>Vocational Engineering Education New Zealand (VEE.NZ)</u> with provider accreditation from <u>Engineering New Zealand</u>, the professional body for the engineering profession in New Zealand. This accreditation provides graduates with international recognition under the <u>Dublin Accord</u>.

New Zealand is currently experiencing a <u>long-term engineering skills shortage</u>, which means there is generally strong demand for NZDE graduates.

The NZDE also provides clear pathways to further study and professional recognition.

Further study: Bachelor of Engineering Technology

Professional recognition: The NZDE satisfies the benchmark academic requirement for Chartered Membership of Engineering New Zealand <u>CMEngNZ (Eng. Technician)</u> and <u>International Engineering Technician (IntETn)</u> registration.
